

UPC BAR CODES instead of LABELS



For more than 30 years, *Labels for Education* has been awarding free educational equipment to school in exchange for proofs of purchase from the Campbell family of brands. It's a fund, easy program where students, families, and members of the community work together for a common goal. Today over 80,000 school and organization are registered with Labels for Education, benefiting more than 42 million students.
